

**Athletic and Activities Participation Policy**  
(approved, 5/20/13)

In addition to Rockwell holding student's accountable for their academic standing in order to play or participate in school athletics and/or activities, the school likewise expects that the students otherwise represent Rockwell Charter High School as an actual student of the school.

The Utah High School Activities Association allows students from charter schools to try out for and participate on teams and/or in activities at their geographical school if such a sport or activity does not take place at Rockwell, a school of choice. As a purposefully small school, Rockwell reserves the right to only allow students who are enrolled at least half-time at the school to participate in any UHSAA or other athletics and activities.

Students are expected to honorably maintain academic standards and take care of any expectation regarding fees to be paid. Students expecting to play or participate at their local school must uphold the higher standards, as Rockwell is required to pay the school a fee. Students not upholding Rockwell standards are expected to pay their own fee plus the school's fees.

Students must maintain a minimum schedule of at least 4 classes to be considered half-time students. This does not include release time periods as the whole point of release time is to give options to the student for religious or other studies. Students registered for college classes through Rockwell are considered Rockwell students.
