Fees are due the first day of school. Arrangements for a payment plan can be made through the front office.

Fee Waivers: You must apply at Rockwell Charter High School's front office. Those who qualify for free and reduced lunch automatically qualify for fee waivers. Please bring a copy of your most current income tax return and a recent verification of receiving Supplemental Security Income payments (SSI) or Aid to Families with Dependent Children (AFDC) payments. It is necessary that each family be approved **annually**. Those families whose applications are denied will owe fees.

Fee Refunds: Any withdrawal after 14 days of student enrollment will not receive a fee refund.

Lunch Fees: School breakfast and lunch are offered Rockwell every school day. These costs are separate from school fees.
